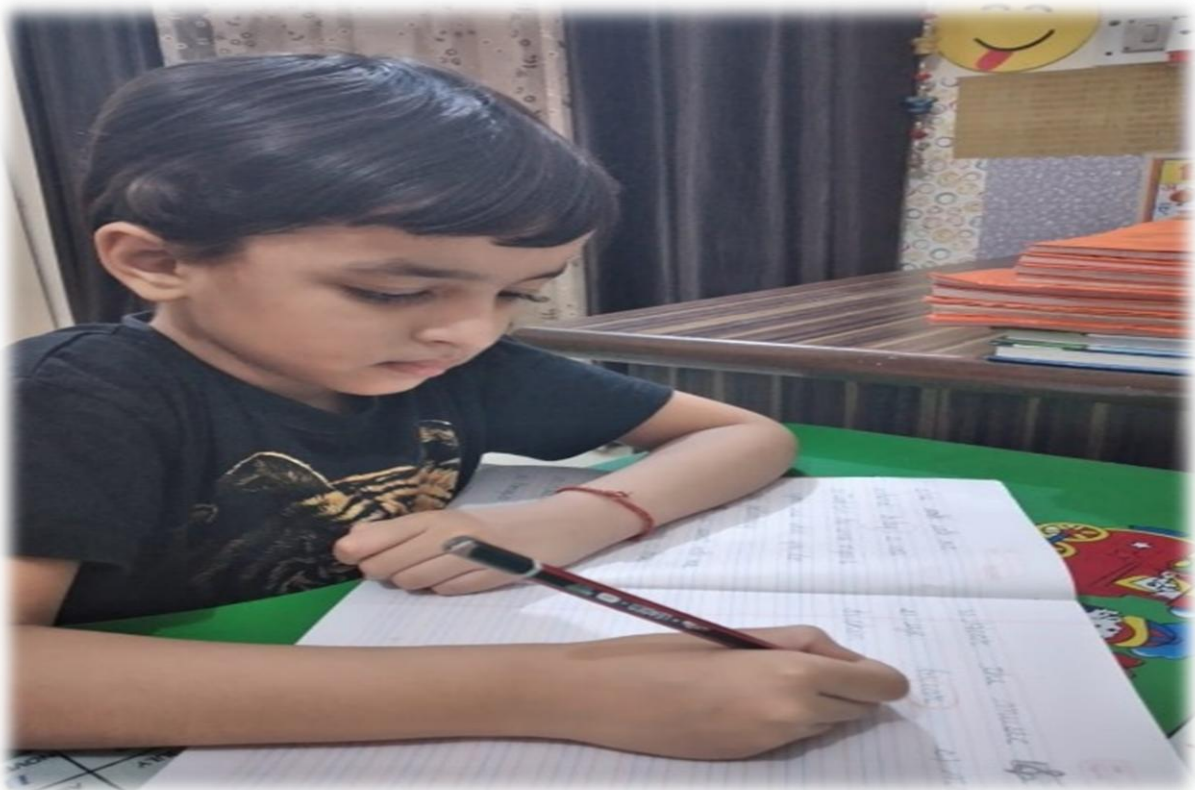




DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, VINDHYANAGAR

Lockdown further extended. Online classes are running as per schedule along with Active Daylive Fitness sessions, since there is nothing as precious to man as a sound mind in a sound body.



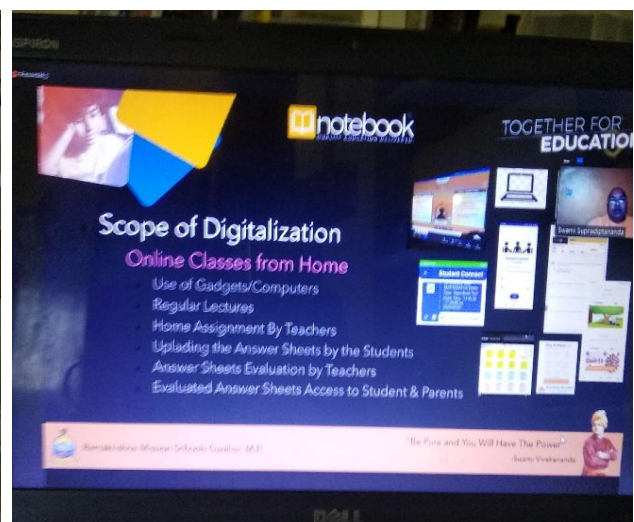
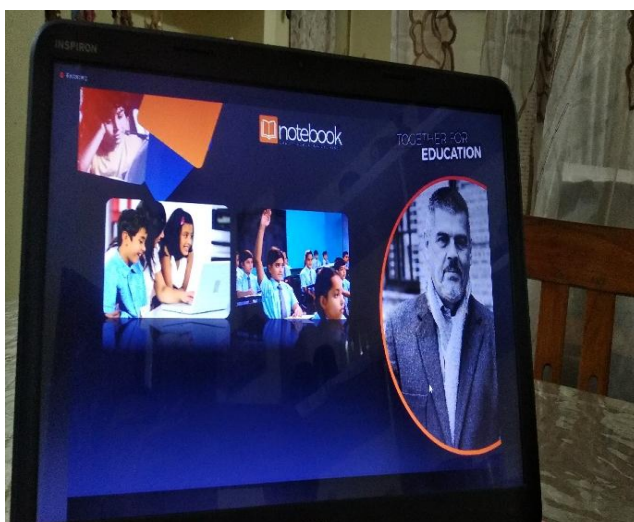
5TH MAY 2020:

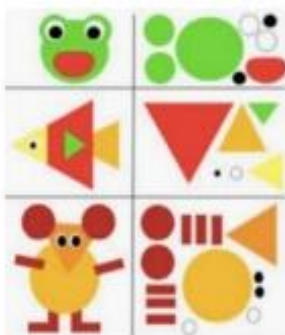
4. **Creative Zone:** Make Shaped Animals (any five).
