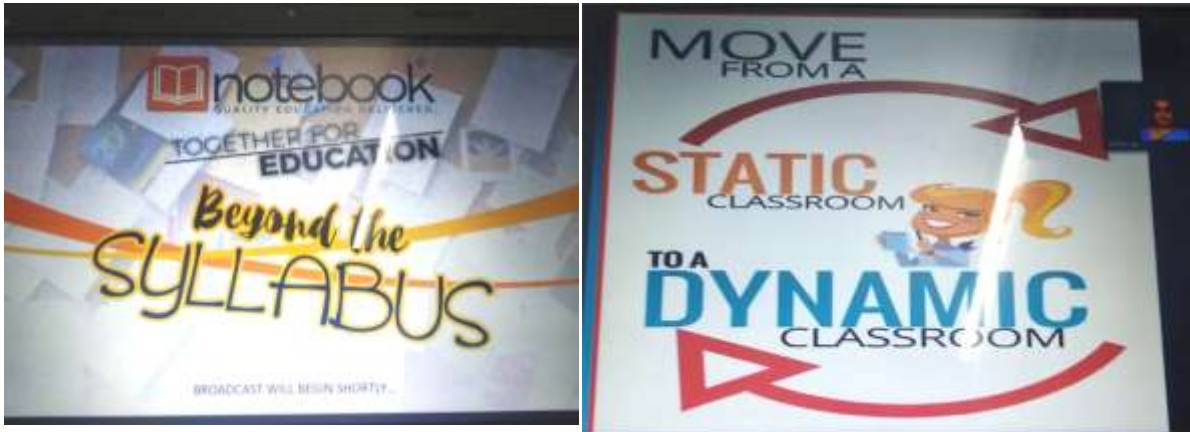

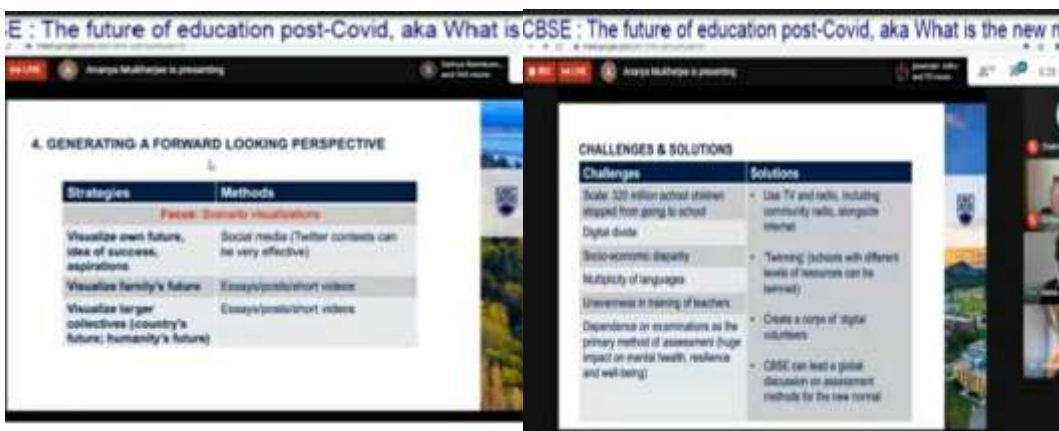
18TH JULY 2020:

21ST JULY 2020:

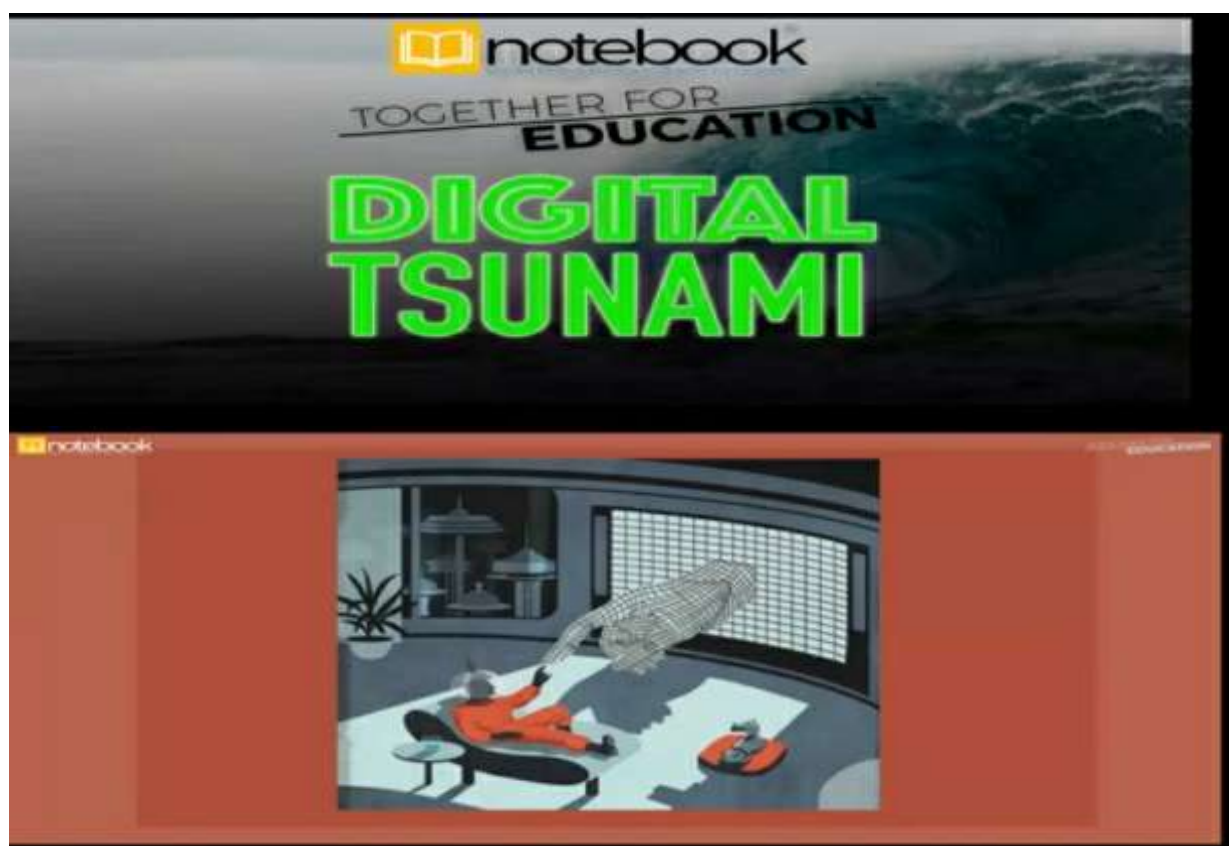

2.7.2020 :

3.7.2020 :

Principal , Dr. Janardan Pandey called for a meeting through Jio Meet app to discuss the pattern of question paper and other important issues regarding Periodic Test for 6-8 and Pre mid term for 9-12 classes .

4.7.2020 :

Circular no. acad.44/2020 by CBSE Director (Academics) provided links to reach Diksha portal and CBSE website and go through Cogito and the question series - a series on thinking

skills. The same was circulated to all the teachers and were instructed to update themselves with latest advancements of CBSE .

5.7.2020 :

i. Online experiential learning course by TATA Trust TISS & MGIS Collaboration invited all the educators to learn how active application of senses can help us learn reasoning and reflection in an effective way .It provided course teaser ,link & core course form.

Diksha portal's link was provided to teachers and they were motivated to go through it and enrich themselves with new innovative updates .

6.7.2020 :
