1ST AUGUST 2020:

The webinar mainly highlighted some of the best online teaching methods followed by different schools for online teaching. - Involve all kids! Interact with all
- Be expressive.

Teachers of Primary Wing attended the webinar on “**DIGITAL USE AND ABUSE**” by Notebook.



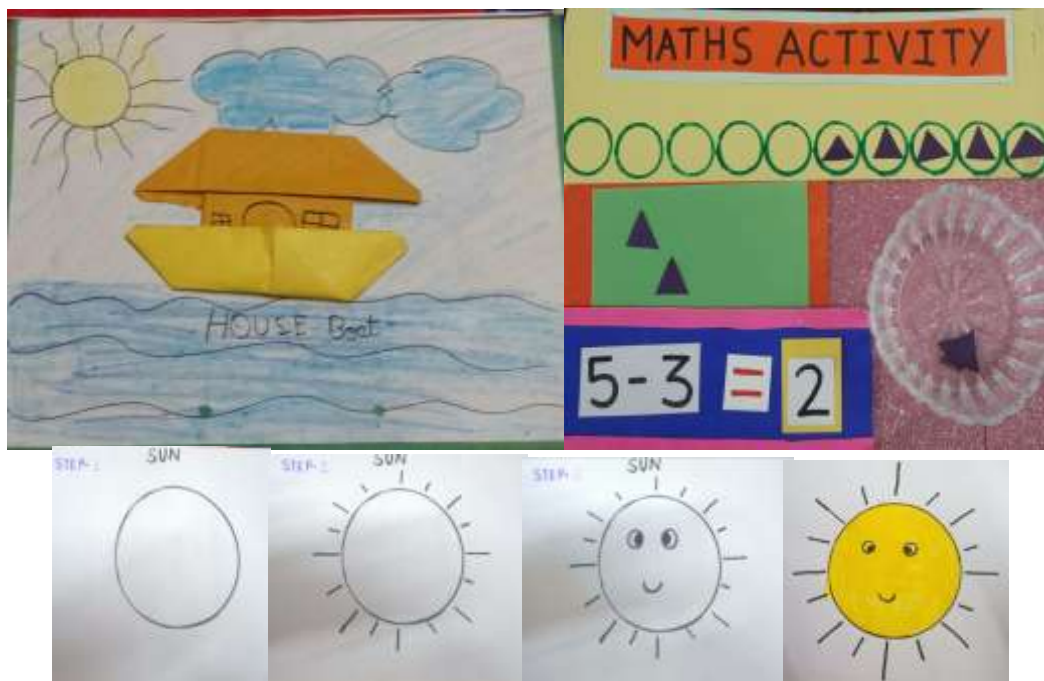
This webinar focussed on the tremendous advantages of technology and the need to strike a balance. To build checks and measures for children

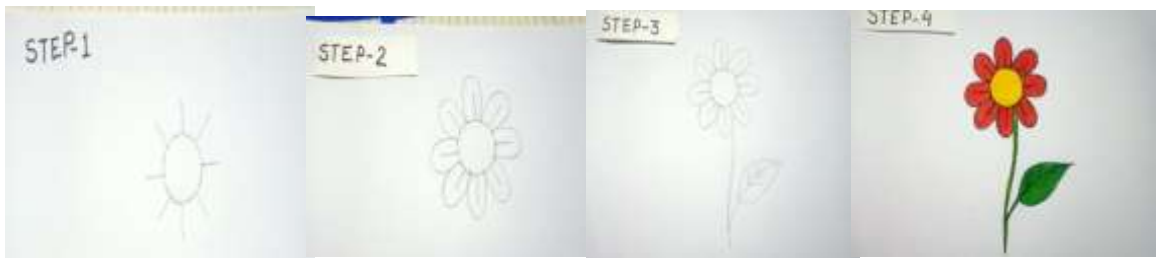
First Parents- Teacher meeting for classes LKG and Prep conducted through Google meet. PTM was conducted on every Friday to communicate with the parents and discuss their problems.

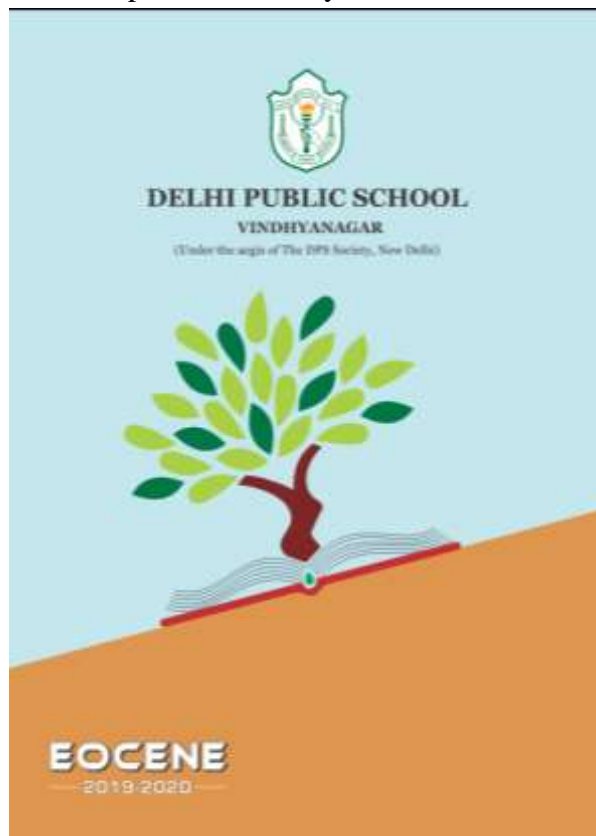
7.8.2020 : FOUNDATION DAY
