CLASSES LKG – II**

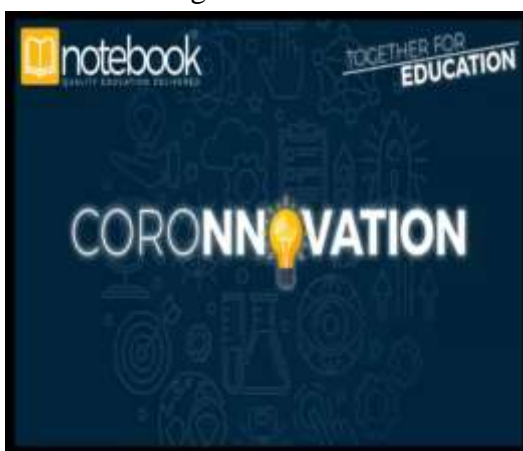
2ND OCTOBER 2020:

For children to know about the deeper significance of the National festivals Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated virtually by the students of Primary wing.



7TH OCTOBER 2020 :

Webinar by notebook on topic “CORONNOVATION” was attended by the teachers of Primary wing. This was an enlightening session which discussed how this Pandemic has been a wonderful time to see man’s innovative spirit develop. It highlighted that how with the reopening of schools we need to handle our children, teachers need to build inspirational rituals, encourage children to be different, encourage them to take risks and make mistakes, to share knowledge and work as a team.



10TH OCTOBER 2020:

Teachers of primary wing attended the webinar on “Mental health” by notebook. This webinar mainly focussed on the basic mental health issues related to young and very young children. The role of the school and the teachers regarding these mental health issues was also discussed. The panelists were of the view that early intervention is very important. Teachers must keep their eyes and ears on the children to notice any strange or changed behaviour. Teachers should communicate with children, teach them emotional regulation skill set etc. The schools can build a well trained team of counsellors, peer mentor team etc and help the child in coming out of the mental stress



Under the “Manodarpan” programme organised during the Mental Health Week by CBSE. Teachers of PW narrated stories highlighting different components of mental well- being and children participated in online Slogan and Poster making competition.



13TH OCTOBER 2020:

PTM on the awareness of covid 19 was conducted virtually. Teachers of PW very well explained what measures need to be taken to stop the spread of Corona Virus, later a pledge for protecting ourselves and others from this virus was also taken.



14TH OCTOBER 2020:

Teachers of primary wing attended the webinar conducted by notebook on “Blended learning”. The webinar which was very educative discussed the changes in teaching learning styles during the post covid period. The panelists were of the view that blended learning would be the way forward which will involve limited teacher contact on a 2-3 days a week, with truncated length of school days. The advantages of blended learning like flexibility, better engagement, differentiated learning etc. were also highlighted.



16TH OCTOBER 2020:

Webinar on the topic: “Early Childhood Care as per New Education Policy 2020” conducted by Macmillan was attended by teachers of primary wing. This webinar mainly dealt with the aims of promoting better overall learning, development and well being of children. ECC would encourage child’s independence and creativity by providing opportunities of self expression, would encourage aesthetic appreciation in the child, empowering the child to be a social being. The different styles of learning which should be incorporated in the lesson plan were also very well explained.



10TH OCTOBER 2020:

Webinar on “Art Integration in teaching For Future Readiness” conducted by Macmillan Education India was attended by the teachers of Primary wing. This webinar mainly focussed on how music can be integrated with various subjects and help students learn better. It highlighted that art is not separate from other subjects and for it to develop creativity is necessary. Art needs to be integrated and not categorized. Art integration should be a solution not a stop gap, so educators should invest in new methods to allow art and creativity to come into their classrooms.



20TH OCTOBER 2020:

Even in this tough situation of the pandemic, we can't stop our kids to perform and enjoy Puja and Dussehra celebrations. Primary wing children joyfully celebrated Durga Puja and Dussehra virtually.

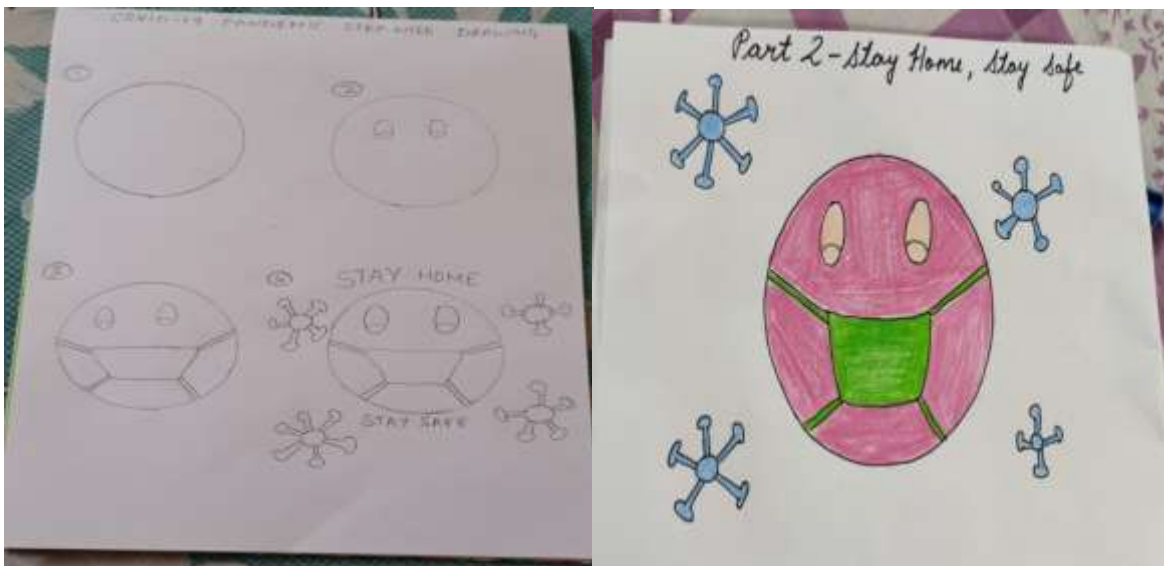


Mrs. Mamta Shukla (PRT) was awarded with a certificate of appreciation by notebook for regularly attending their webinars.

Children were delighted to do an activity of time and learnt the concept of “O’ Clock” and “Half Past”.



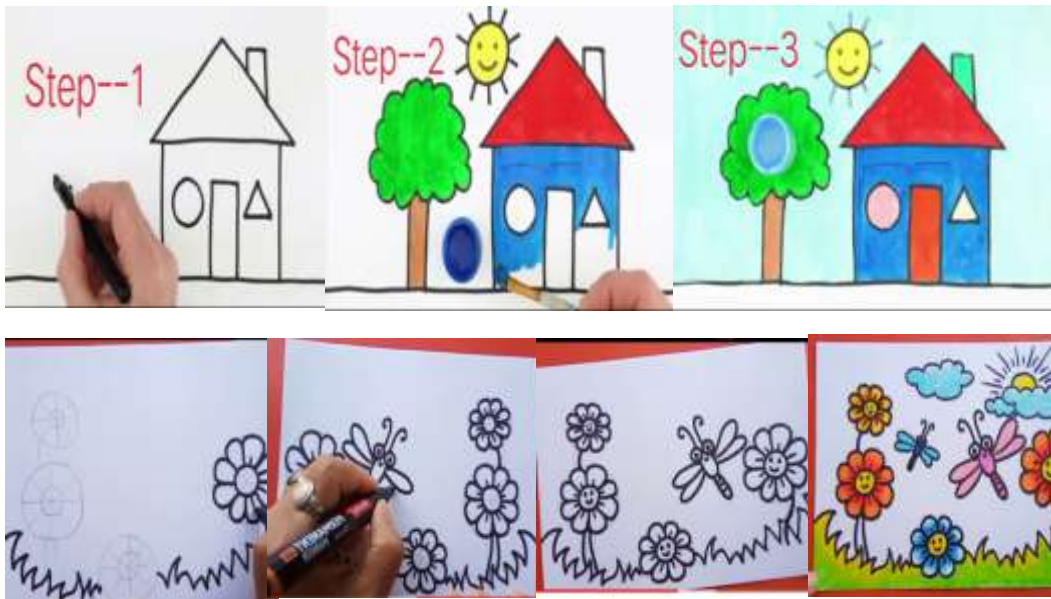
EVS

ART

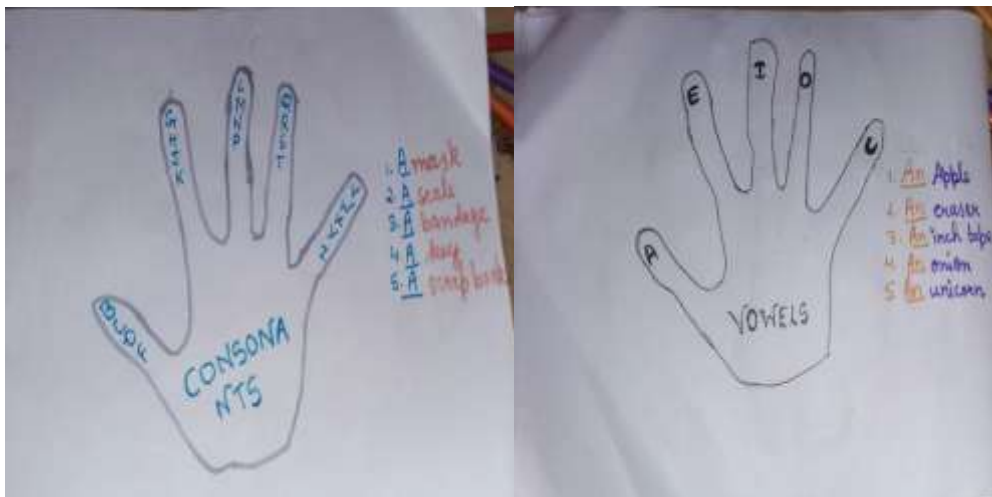
Children rejoiced drawing and colouring ascenery and a house.

Students joyfully learnt about the usage of articles through an activity "Vowels and Consonants in my Hand"



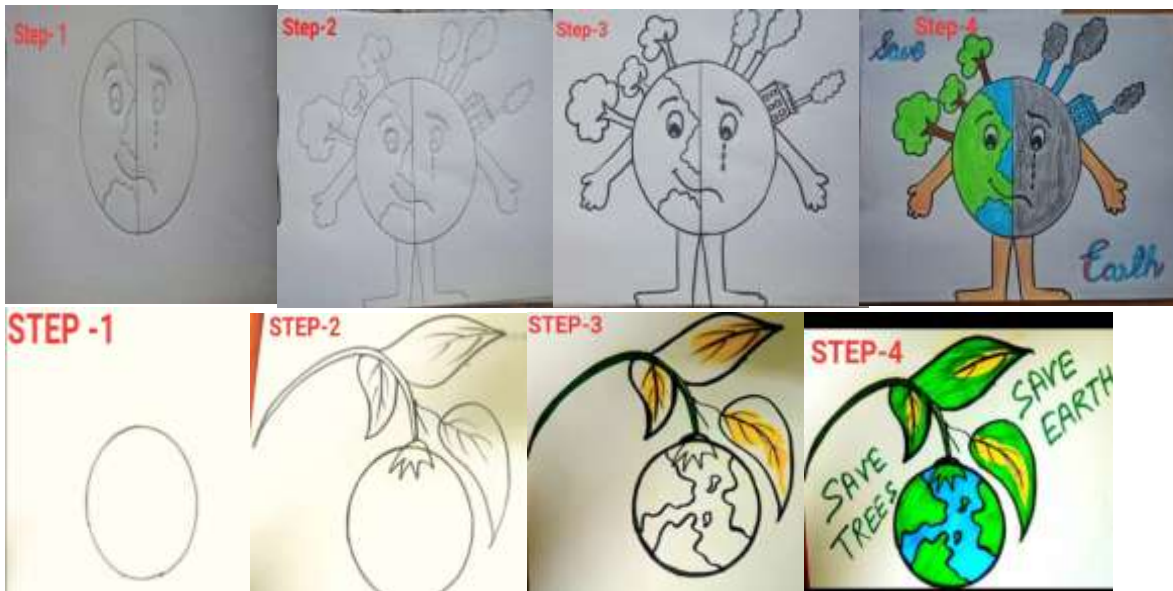
EVS

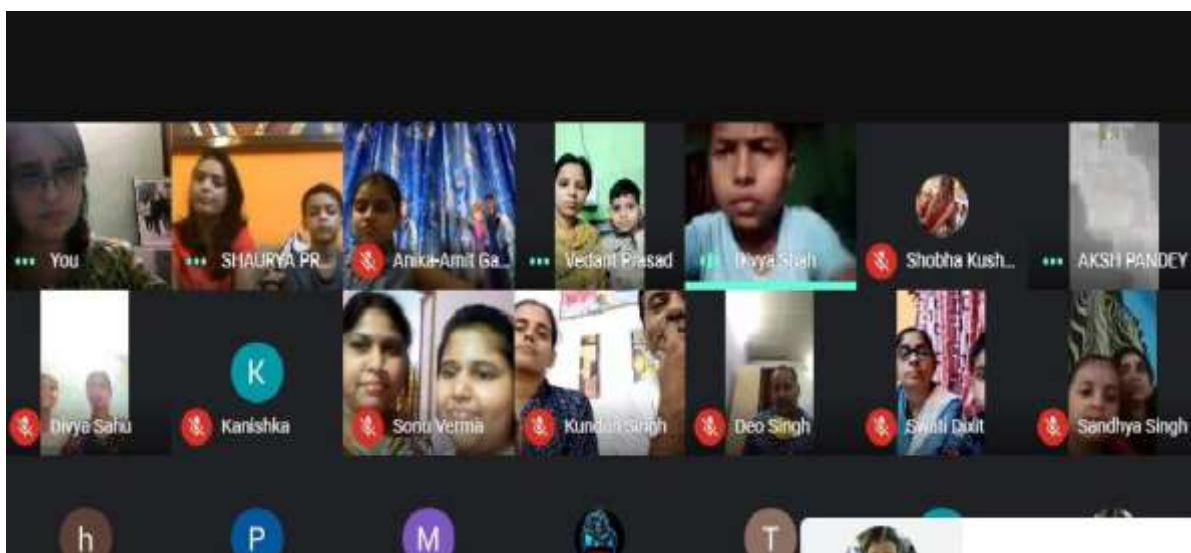
