



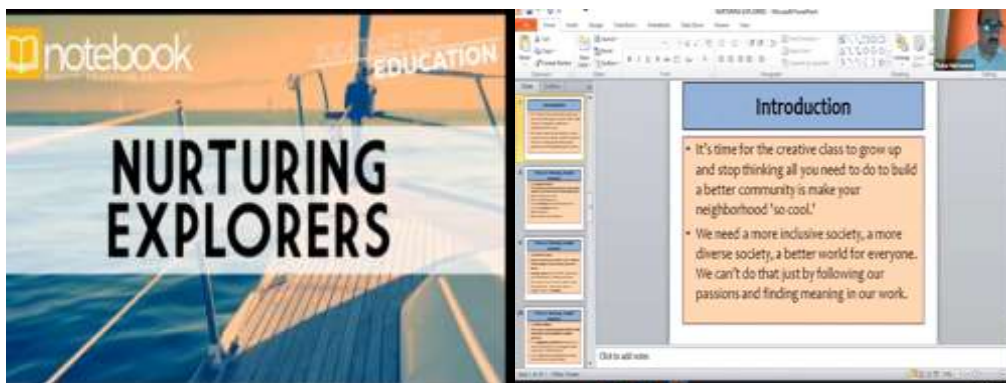
**DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, VINDHYANAGAR**

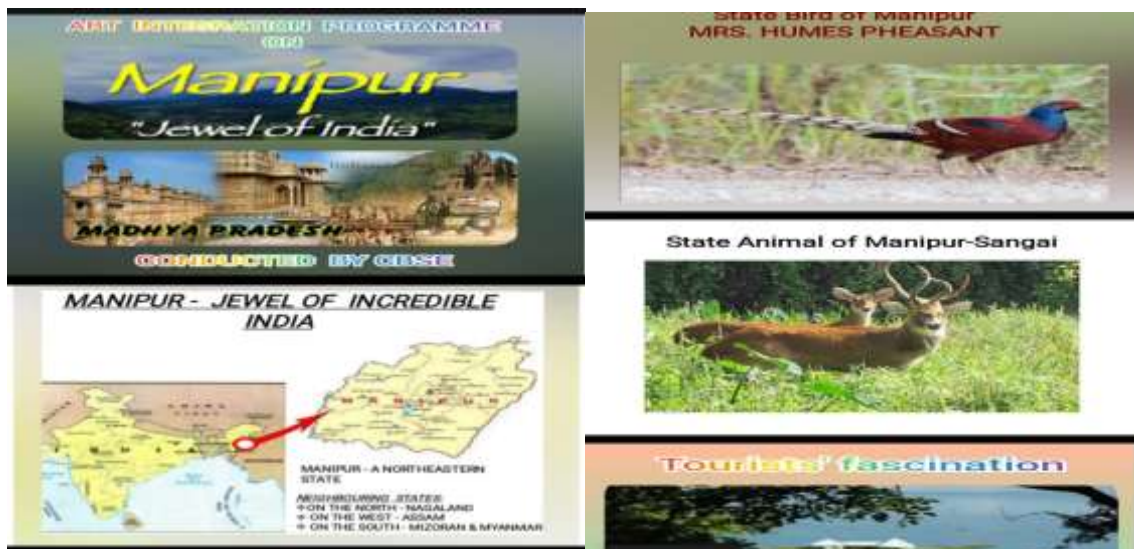

Children cheerfully learnt how to draw a flower basket and stop pollution.



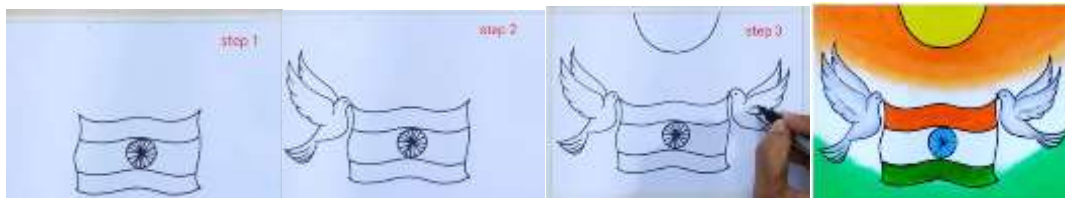


## CLASS II

followed by Chenab House which stood second. Our Honourable Principal Sir congratulated the winners and wished the others for better performance in the future.

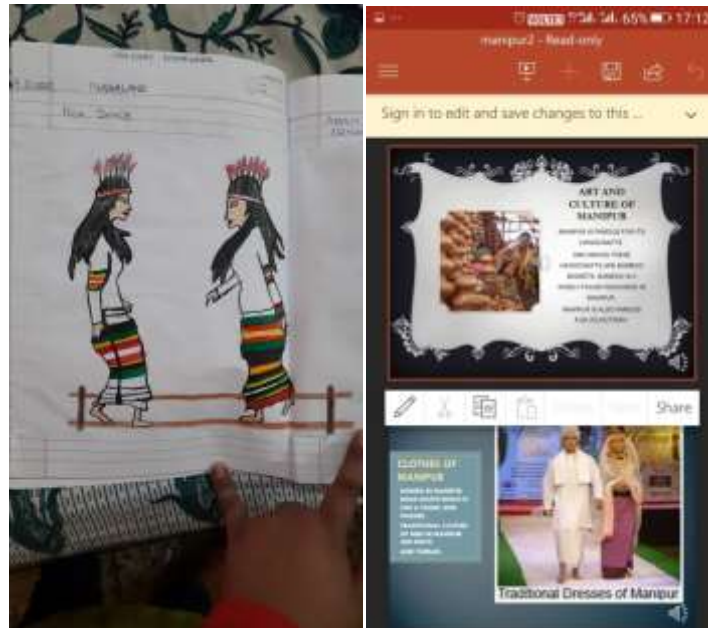


### **DANCE BALLET AUM BY PADMASHREE AWARDEE SHOVARA NARAYAN**
