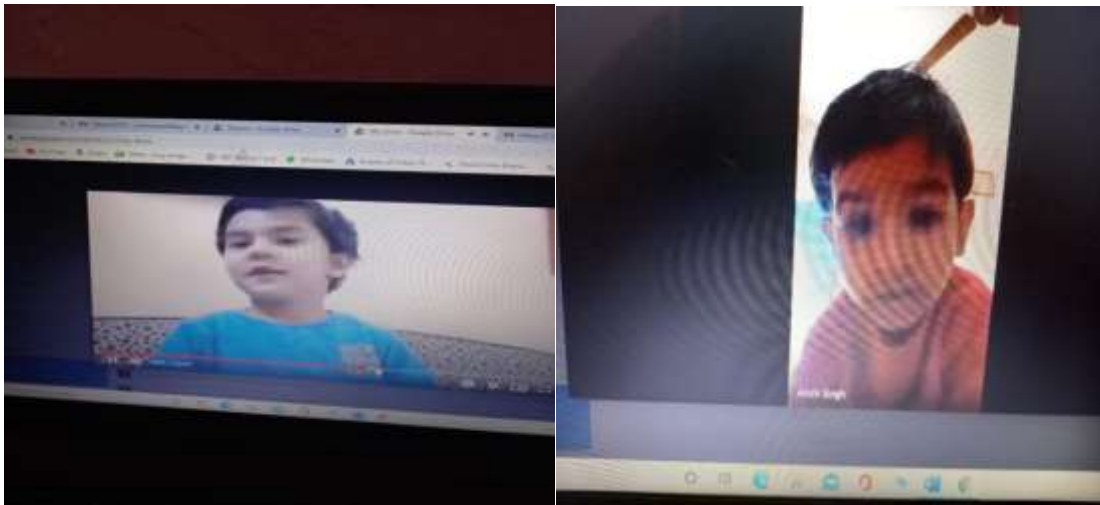




DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, VINDHYANAGAR

1stFEBRUARY 2021: Online admission tests were conducted for classes LKG and Prep through Google Meet.



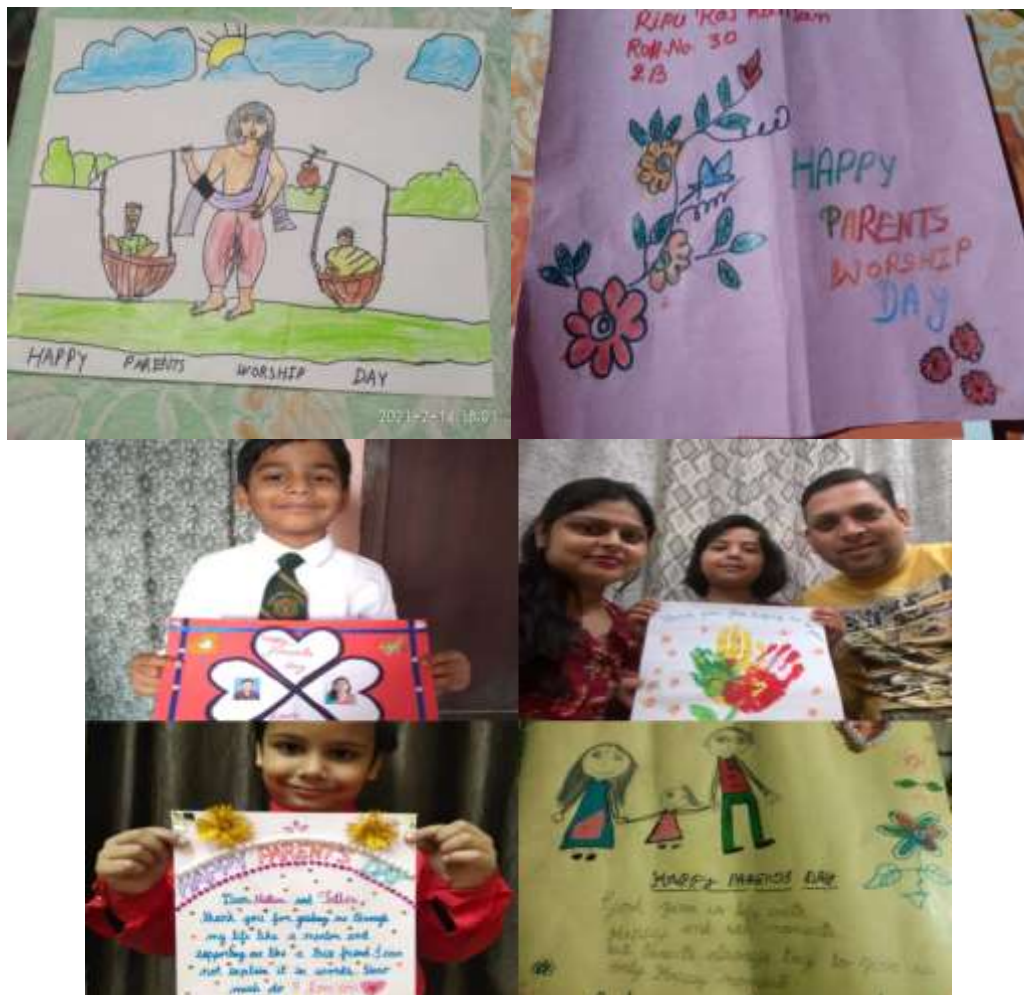

Children enjoyed measuring different objects in centimetres using a scale and cleared their concept of measurement.

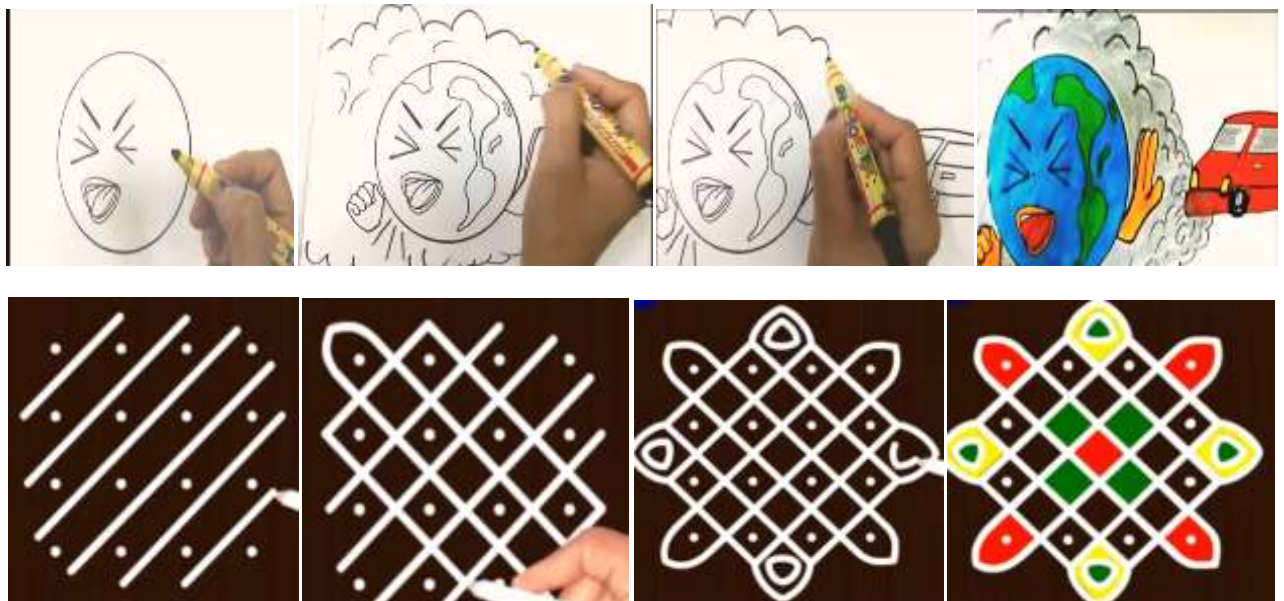

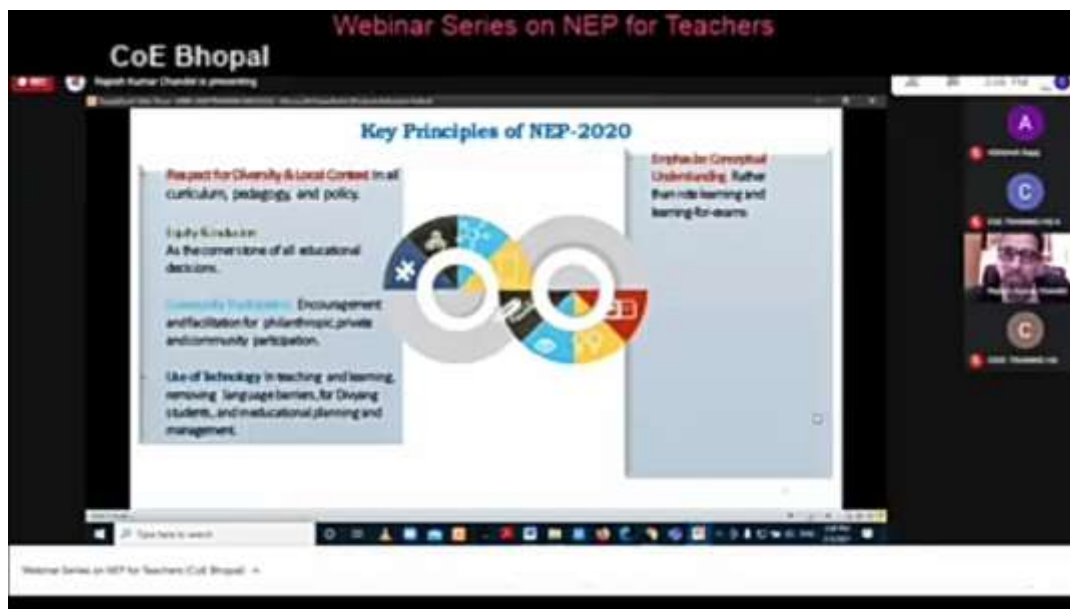
Children were excited to make step wise drawings of Stop Pollution and Rangoli.
