Students enjoyed doing the step wise drawing of “Save Earth.”



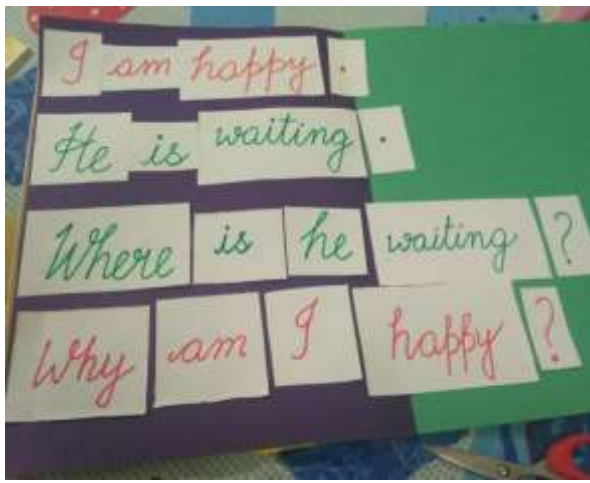
Children joyfully learnt to draw colourful fishes in the pond.

Children learnt about the two types of sentences by doing an activity of questions and statements.



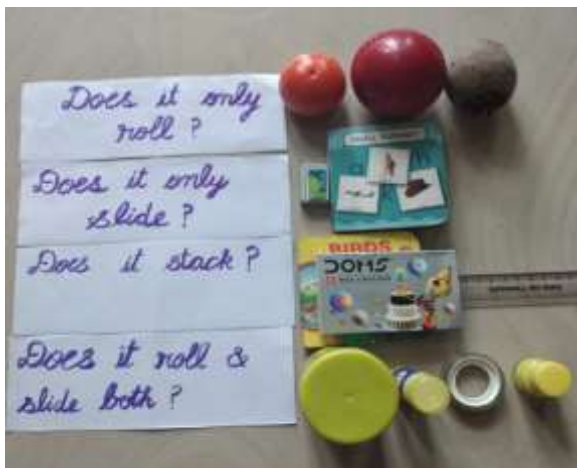
EVS

Children did an activity of objects with flat and curved surface and learnt about things that roll and slide.



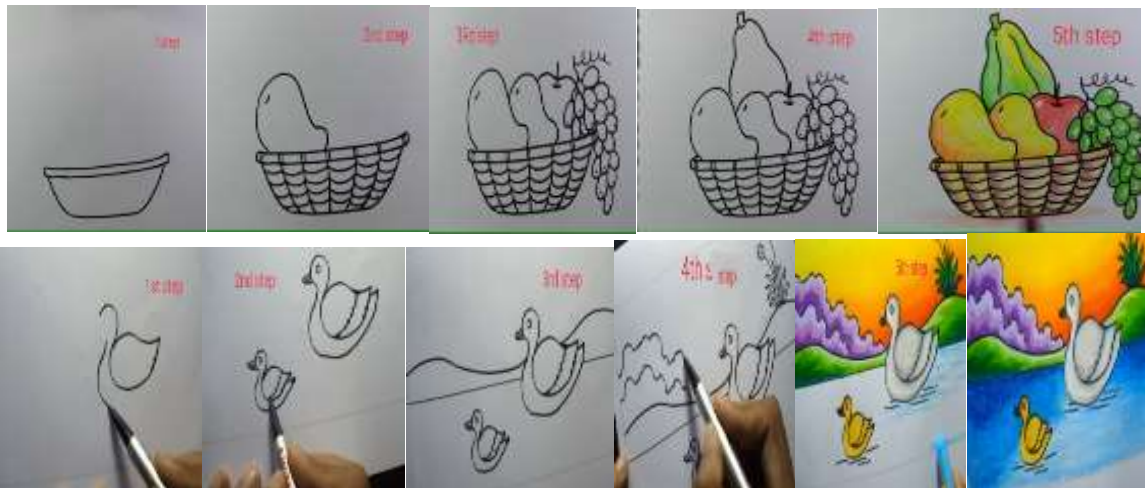
HINDI

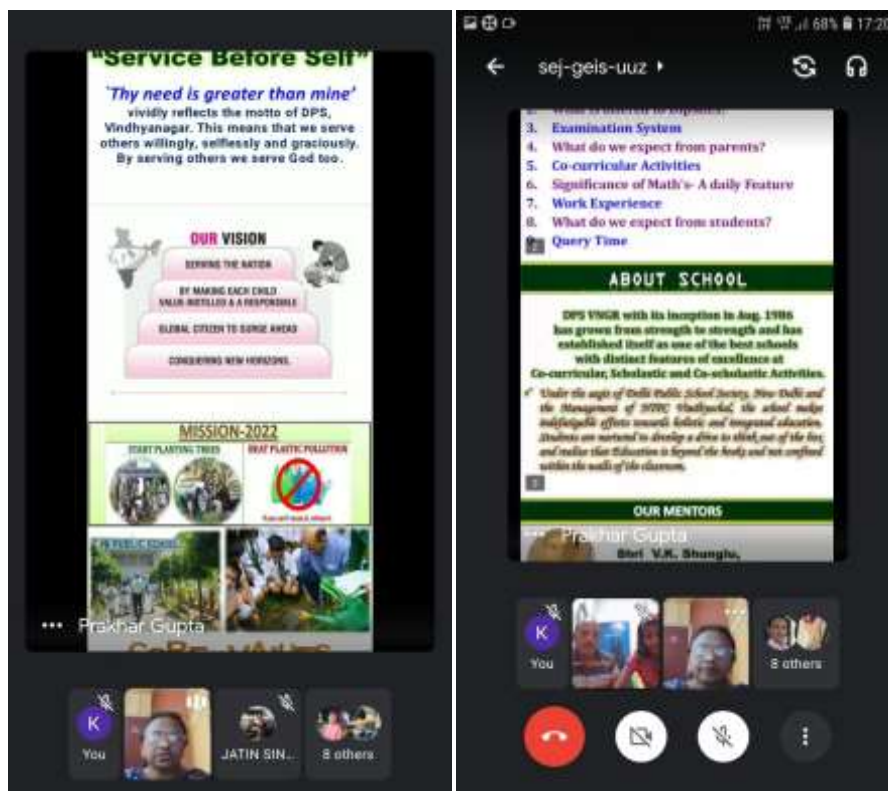

A. Webinar by NTPC on the occasion of World Health Day benefits and importance of regular exercises on this theme will not be nor was taken by

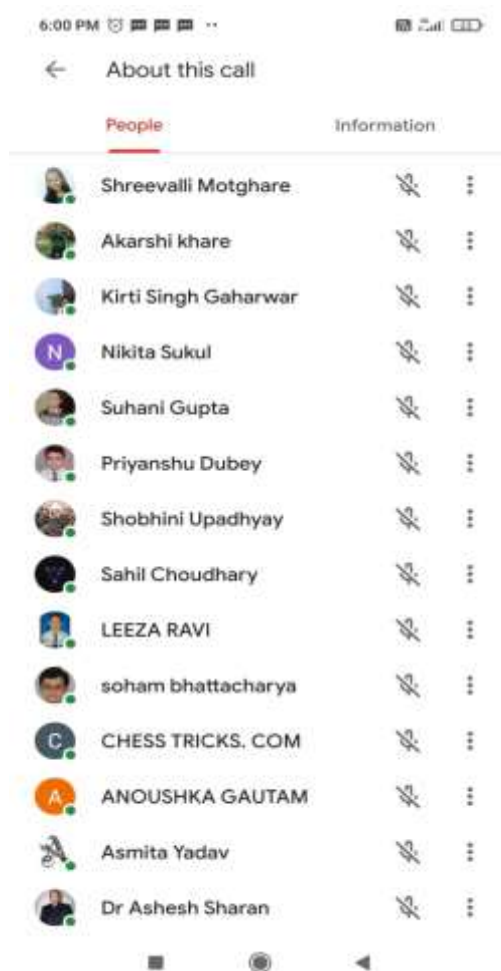
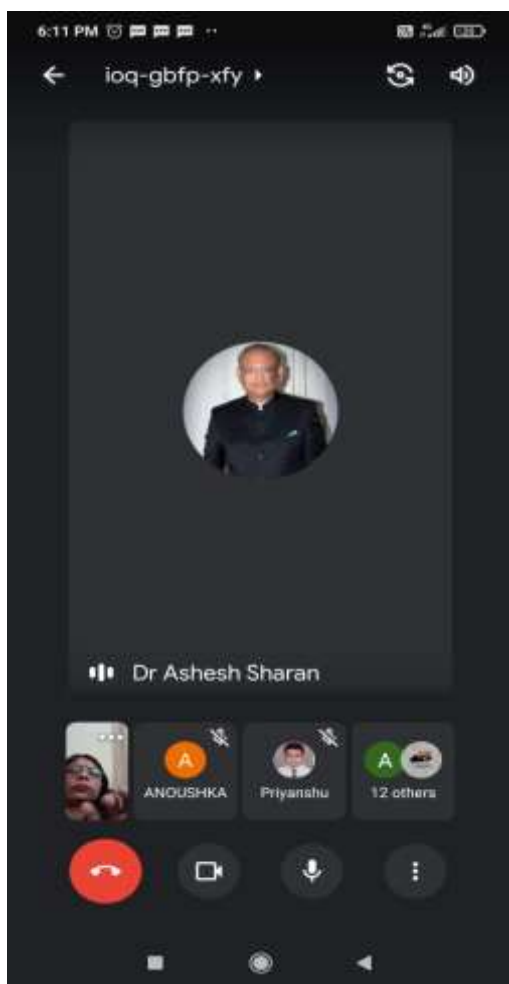
B: Compartment and Re exam of 9th and 11th took place.
