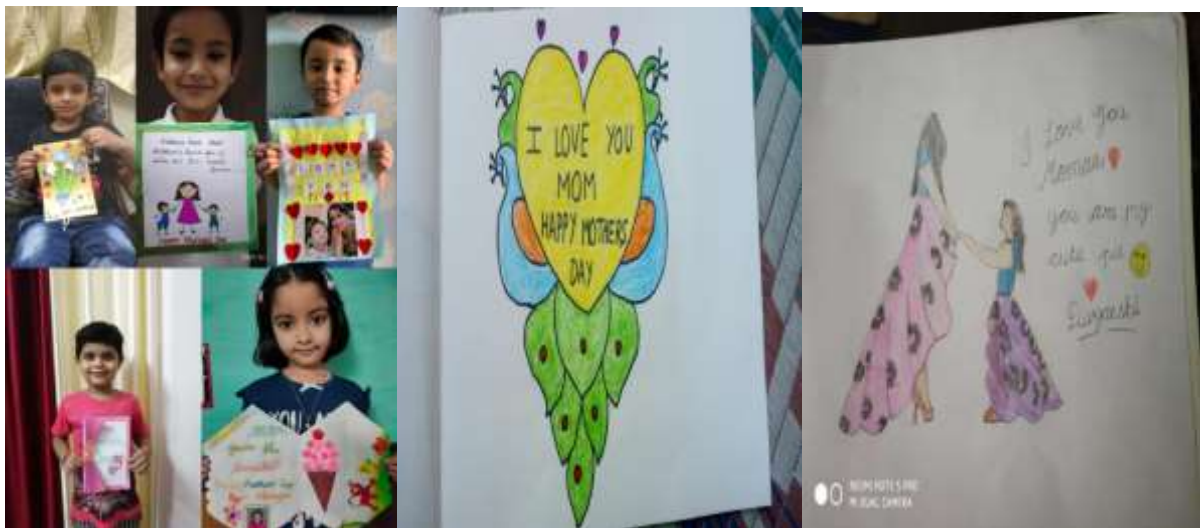


Bi- weekly on line meeting on Monday & Friday were conducted by class teacher to motivate the children and to guide them about the Covid norms.

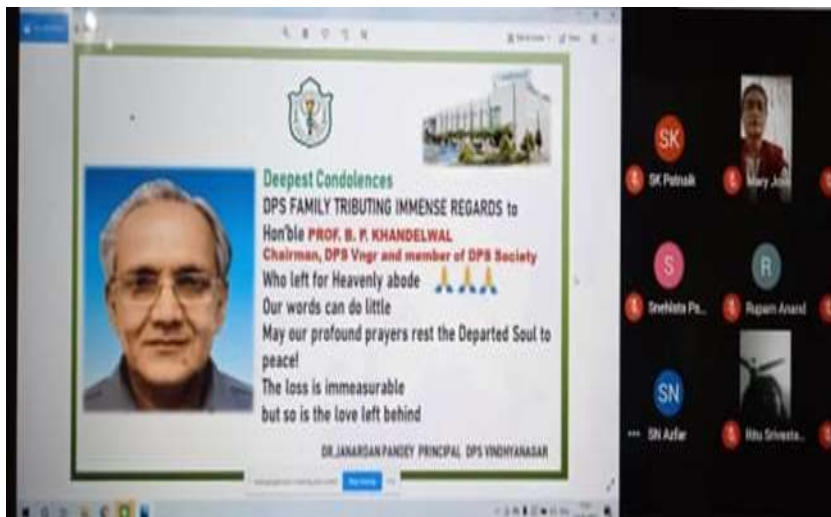

Flipped Classroom / Flipped Learning

There has been a change in the way of teaching in the last years. Technology has played an important role in this change. The increasing use of digital learning and smart devices such as computers, smart phones and tablets has improved student learning. In such a situation, flipped classroom is a new concept in education where students learn at home and participate in related activities in class.

The flipped classroom is completely different from traditional teaching. In this, teachers record their lectures and the videos are posted online, which students can access. Students study at home by watching these videos and when they come to class they prepare with that lecture. The next day, in the classroom, teachers conduct activities related to the posted lectures and students take part in them. If any concept related to the topic is not clear then they can ask questions in class. This allows teachers to focus on the problem of each student. Also, they get more time to interact with the students.

Apart from this, students can also solve their problems with teachers through online chat.

Flipped Classroom transforms the traditional teaching style into a completely new and innovative concept which helps the teachers to teach better and the students to learn easily. It is a type of active learning where there are different strategies to keep the students engaged.

Four Columns of a Flipped Classroom

- 1) Flexible environment
- 2) Learning culture
- 3) Thoughtful content
- 4) Professional teachers

Flip Class is an innovative learning model that inspires and encourages student participation.

In order to move towards competency based education CBSE asked to make corresponding changes in the assessment and exam practices.

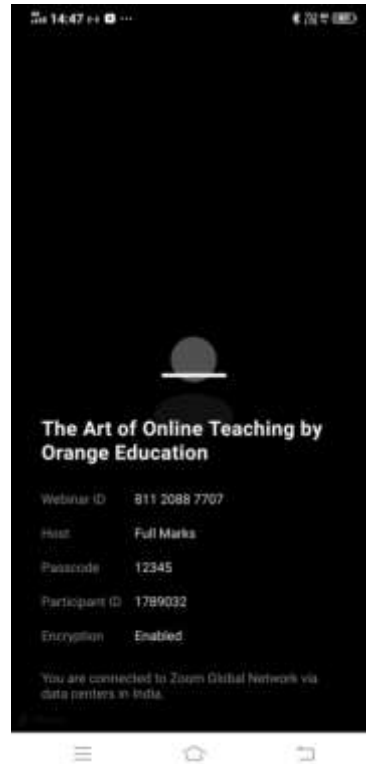
**May 17: Compendium inclusive of LO**
