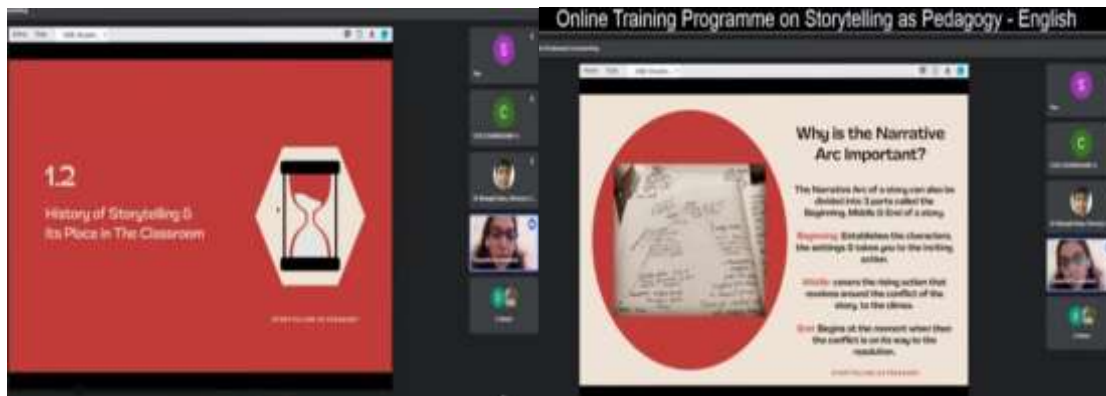

**20<sup>th</sup>JUNE 2021:** Children celebrated Father’s day to honour their fathers and depicted their unending love and gratitude for them.

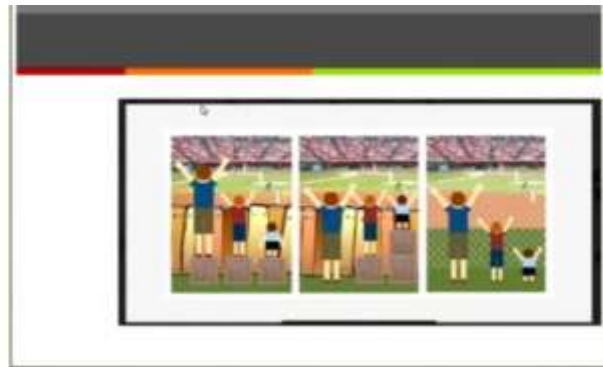

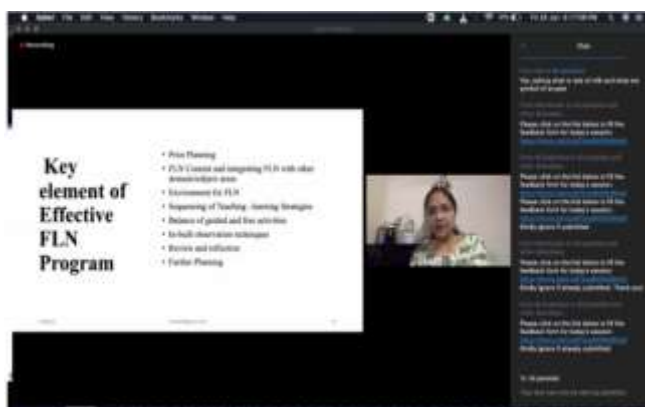

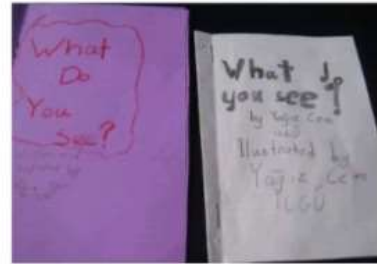

### CLASS- LKG

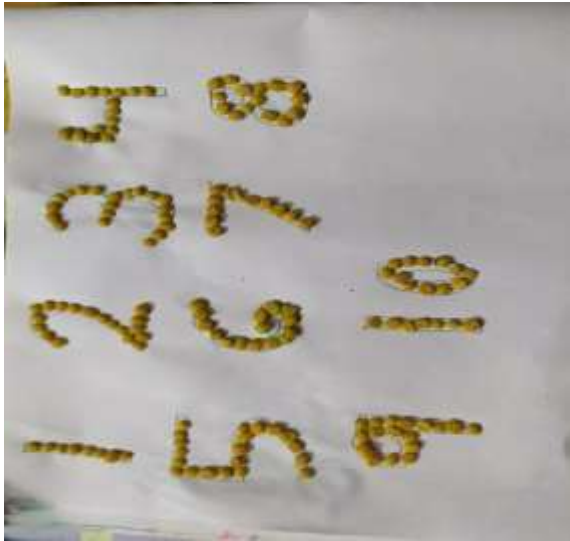
#### ENGLISH

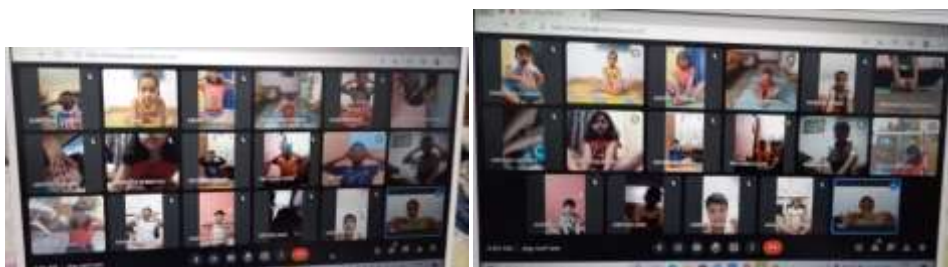
❖ **Zee Mind Wars Quiz link** is shared with the students on every week days. Many students are registering and notching top position for themselves ..

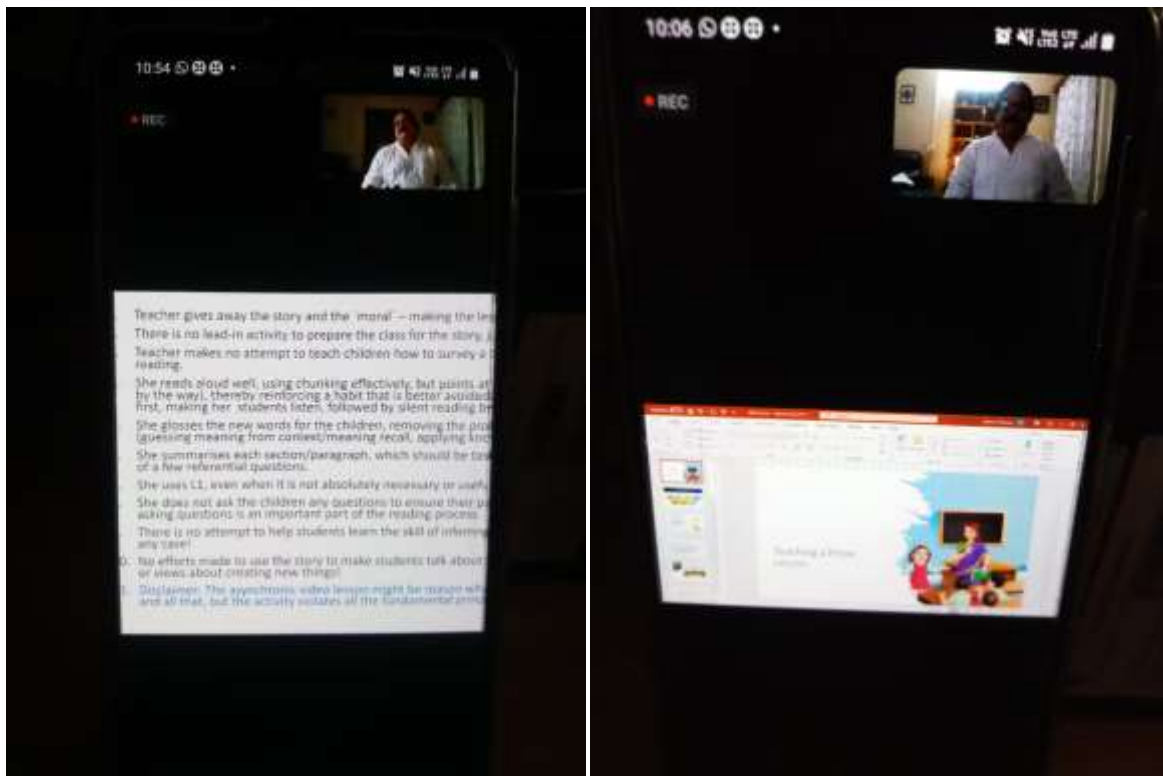

### **Online training programme on story telling as Pedagogy.**

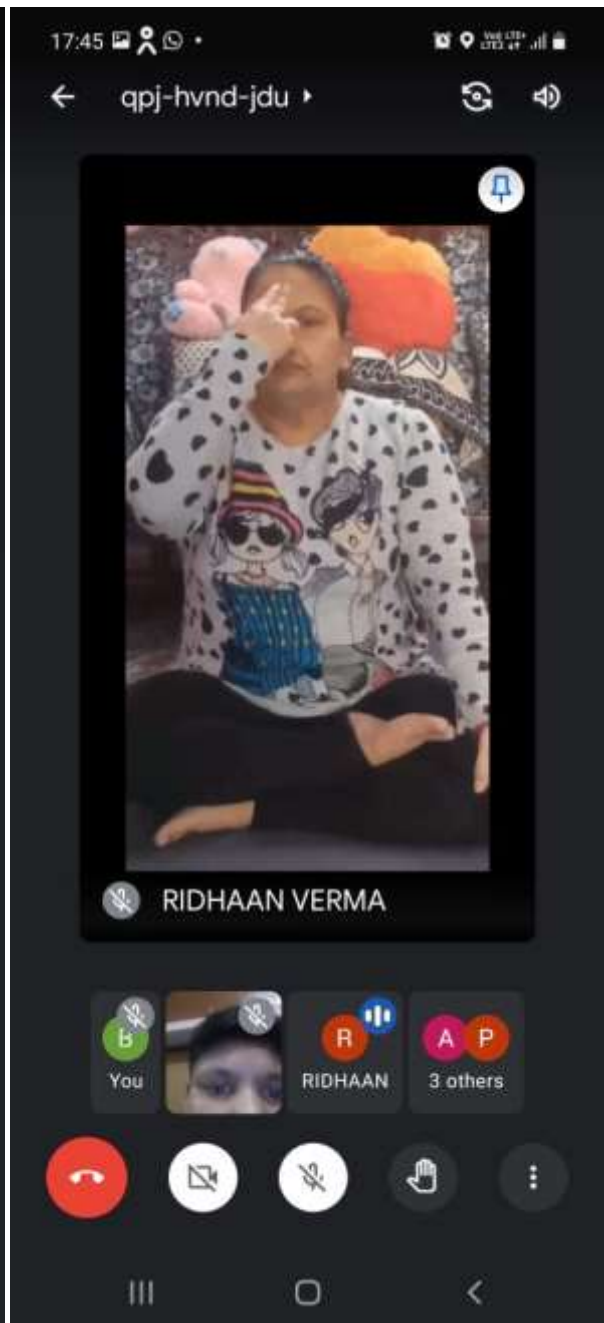
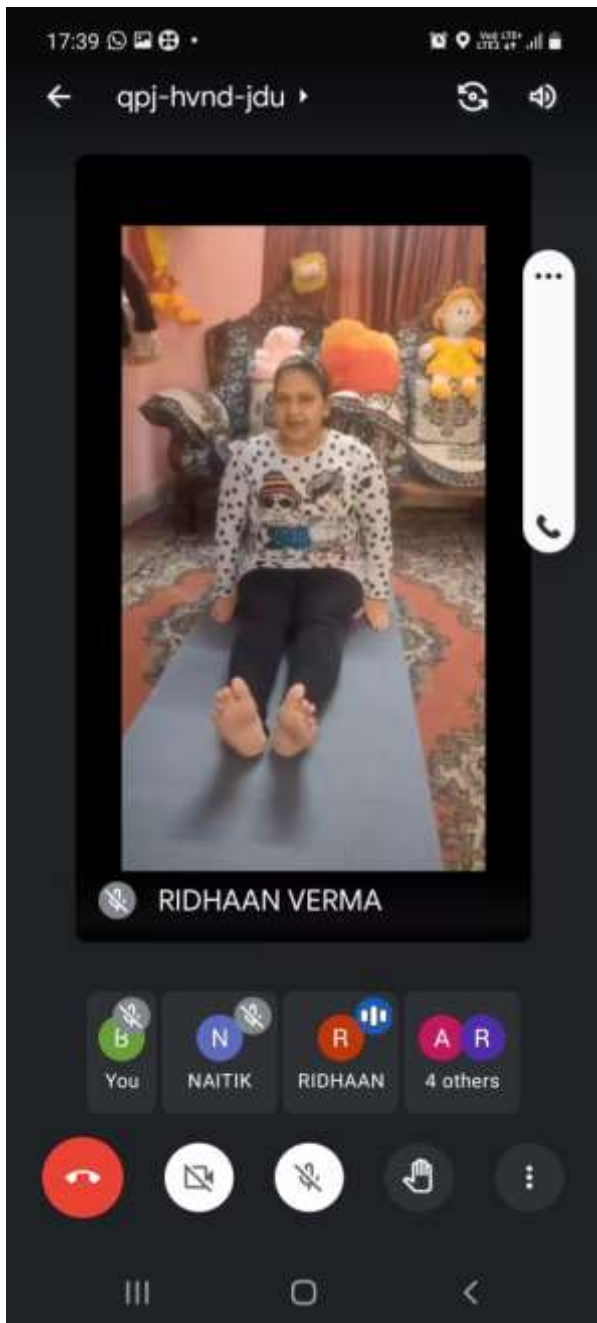
