## ART

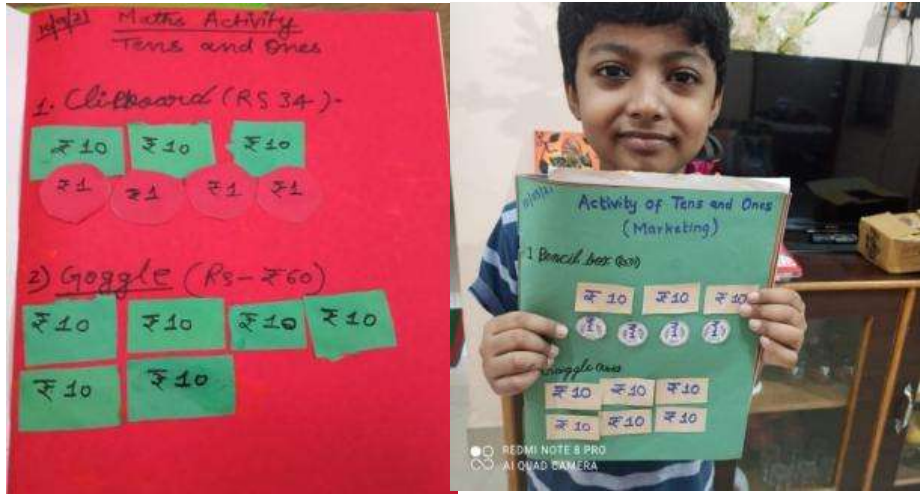
Students were glad to learn how to draw a colourful tree using their palm and spoon. They also learnt to make a rabbit by paper folding.

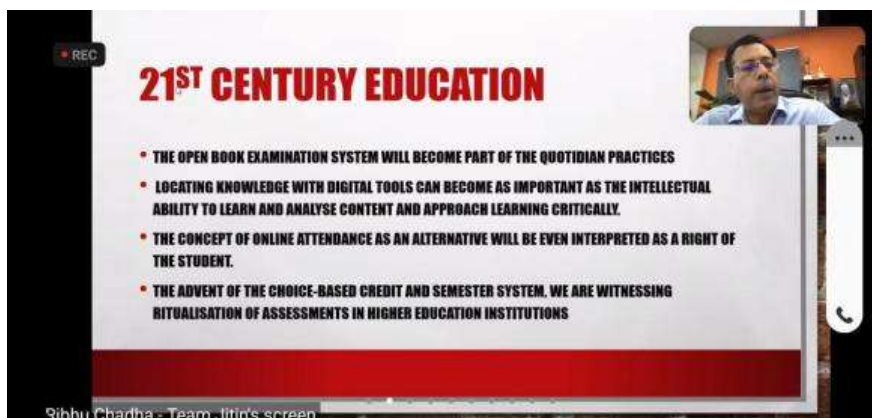


### GREEN OLYMPIAD
