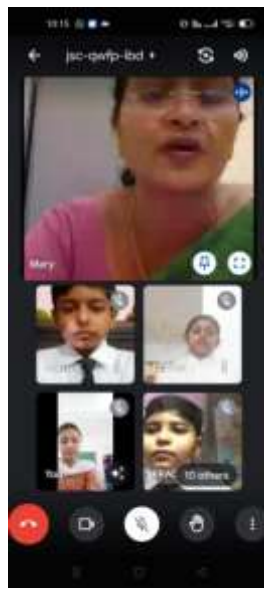

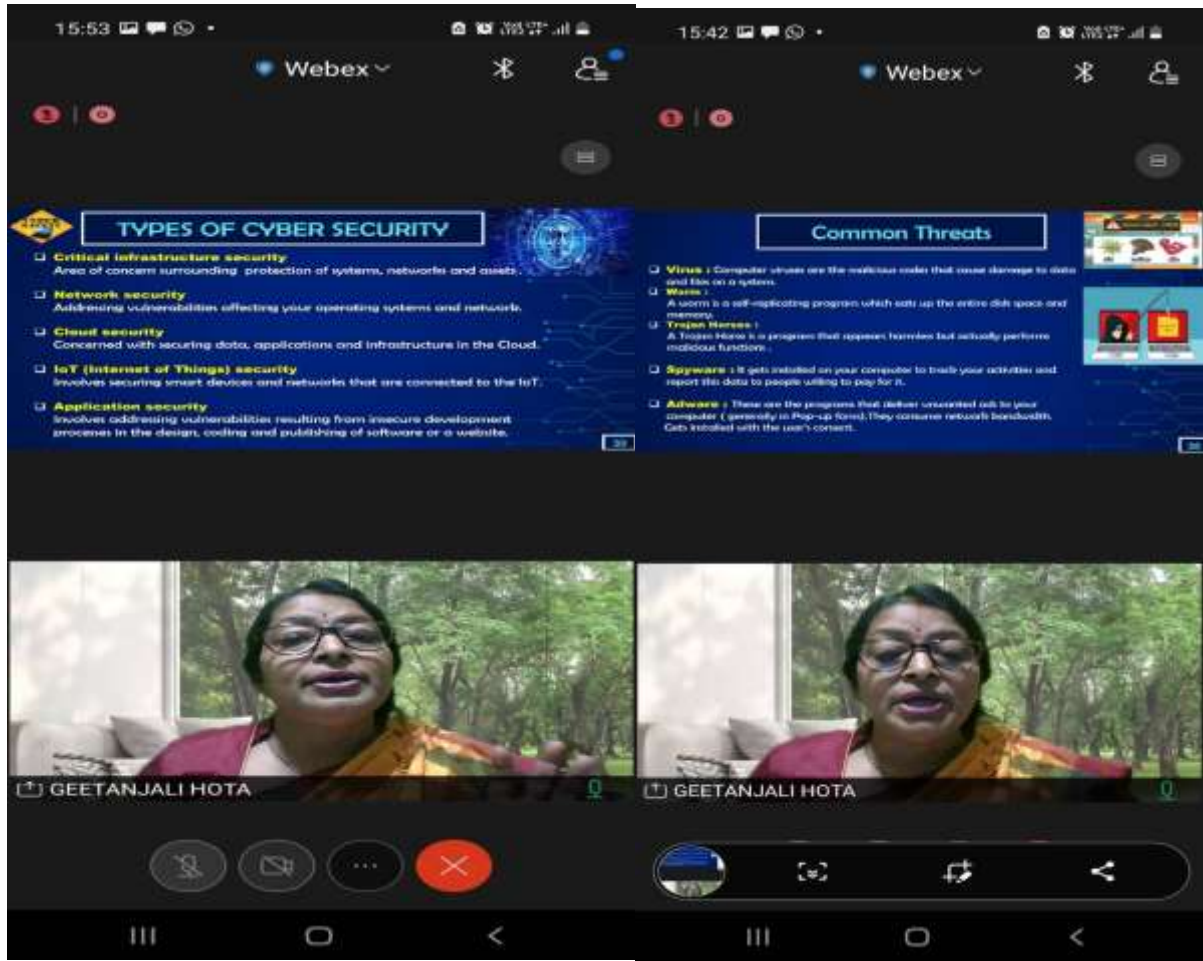
### CBSE TEACHERS TRAINING
