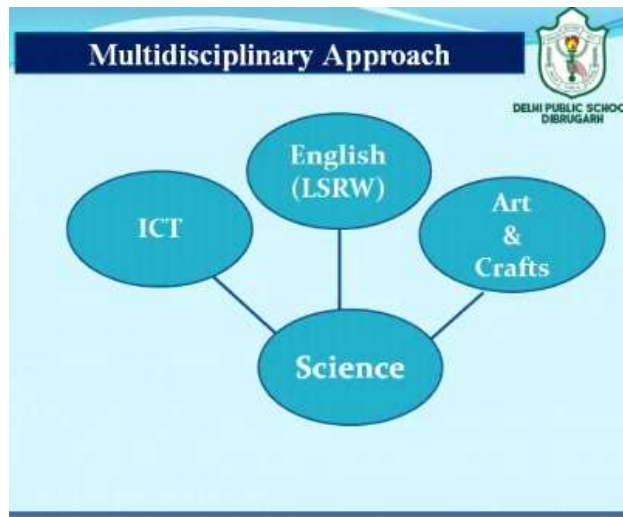

Class 9-12

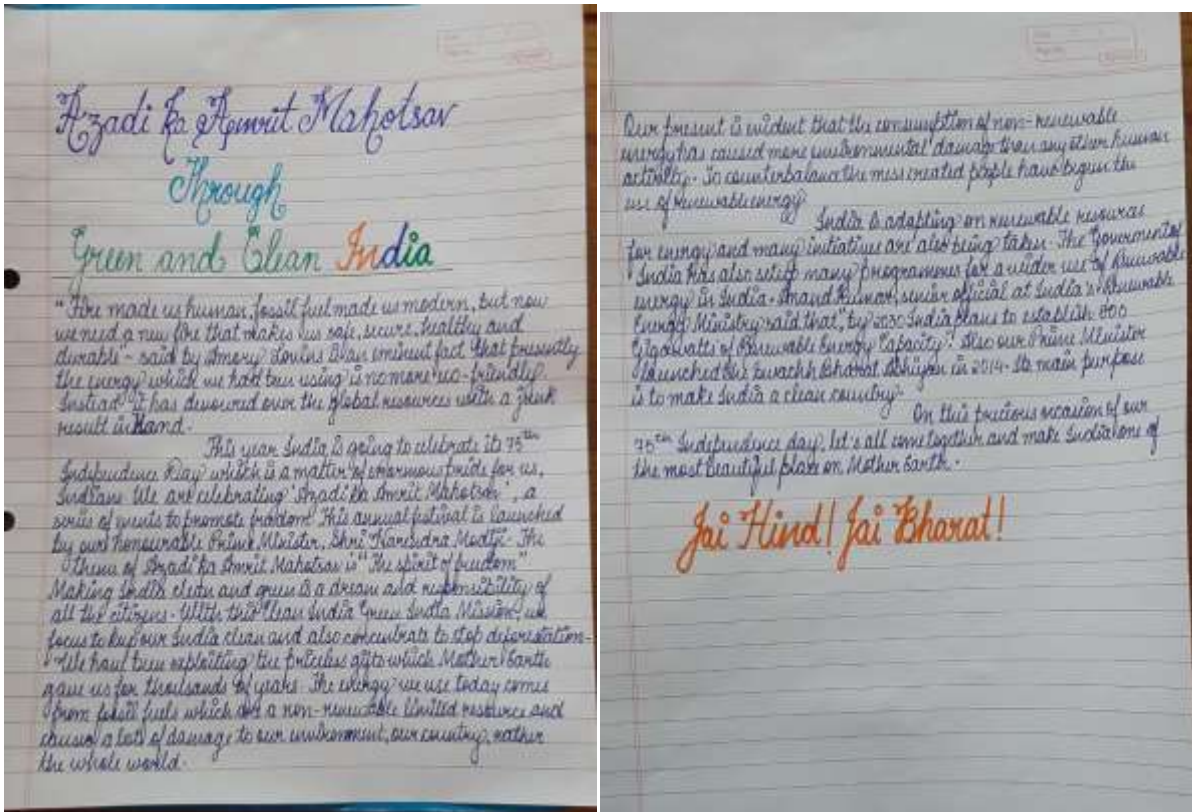
