### CLASS – LKG

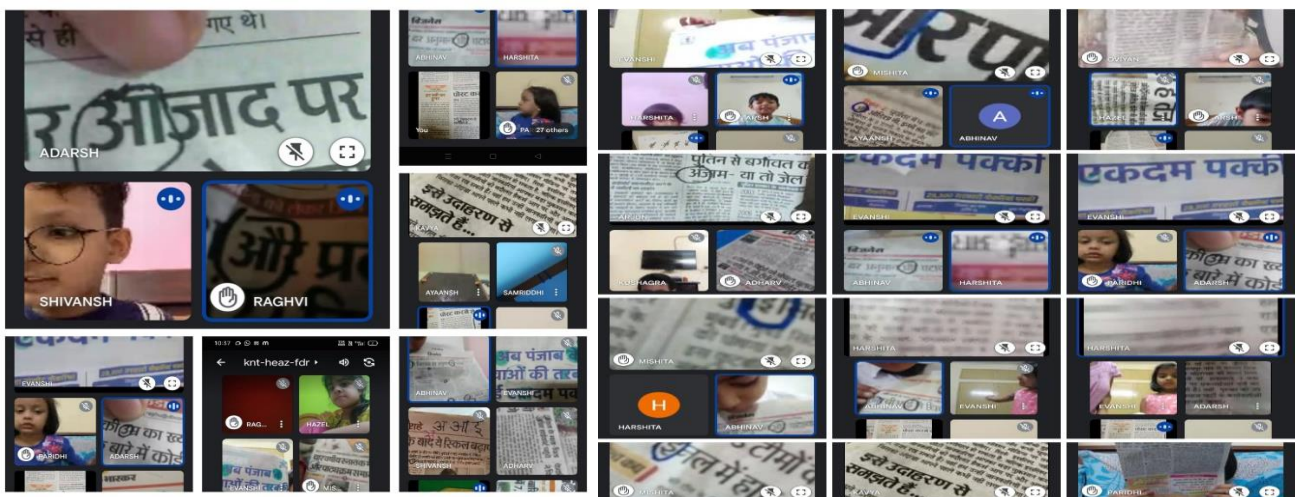
**ENGLISH :** Children enjoyed the “Letter and sound identification of their names“ activity.



**MATHS:** Children gleefully participated in an activity “Tracing the numbers with the help of bindis” which helped them in number identification.

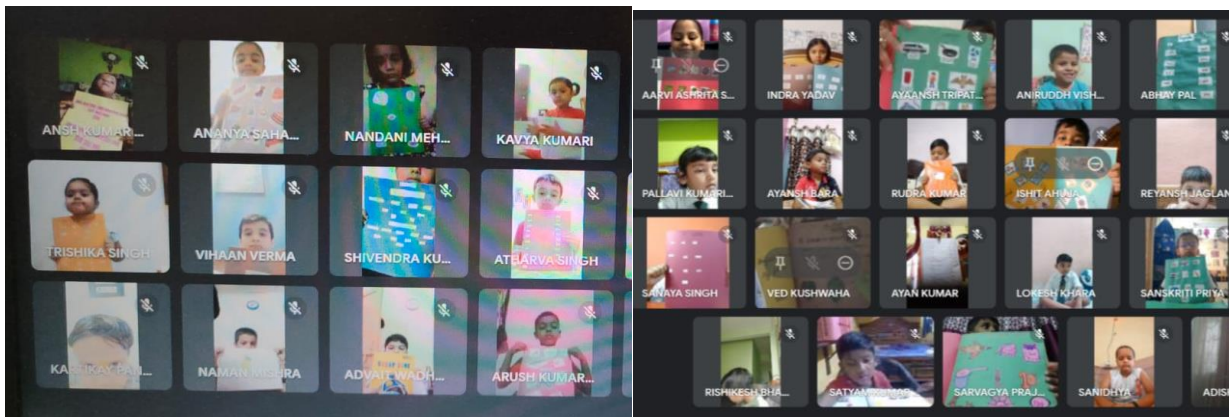


**HINDI:** Children had fun in learning “स्वर” from the words given in newspaper.

- The school celebrated **International Yoga Day** on 21 June. PPT, Speeches, Yogasans etc. are parts of the celebrations.

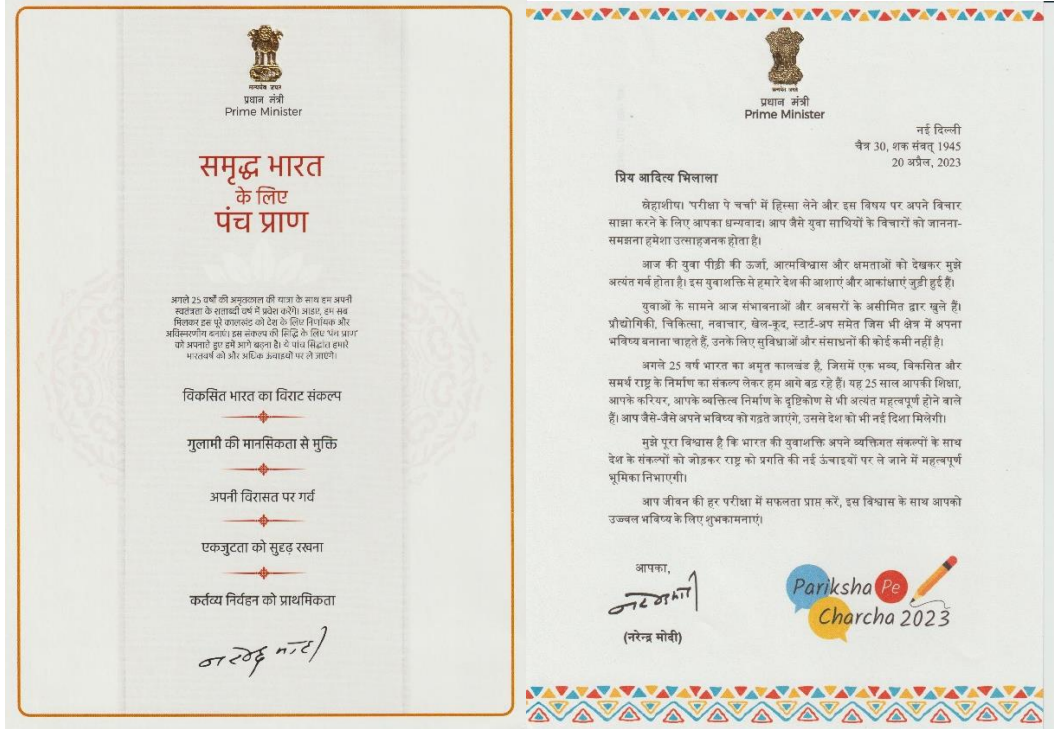
